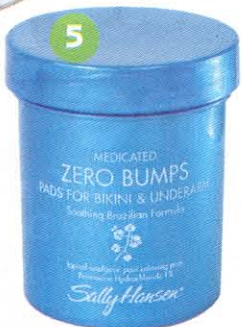

# BODY FIXERS

**4 Tackle bug bites** Spray insect repellent over all exposed skin (spritz onto hands and pat over face) and clothes before going outside. Sensitive skin? Try a natural citronella balm. "Stay away from perfumes, which can attract more bugs," warns NYC dermatologist Bruce Katz. Already bitten? Apply an anti-inflammatory cream regularly, such as hydrocortisone.

**5 Banish bikini bumps** Prevent ingrown hairs by using an exfoliating wipe with salicylic acid postshaving or waxing. To calm irritated skin, look for a product that also contains soothing aloe.

**6 Soothe sunburn** "Sit in a cool bath to help bring your body temperature down," Katz tells *Us*. Then, slather on an aloe gel every four hours to reduce inflammation.

**7 Cover uneven tan lines** "Apply a shimmery body bronzing cream [all over] to minimize variation in skin tones," suggests makeup artist Sue Devitt.

# FACE FIXERS

**8 Get rid of an oily T-zone** Loose and pressed powders may soak up shine, but they can also feel heavy on summertime skin. A lighter option? Apply an oil-absorbing gel like Lola Cosmetics Refine Shine gel (\$24, [sephora.com](http://sephora.com)) before applying makeup to prevent slick spots. Touch up your skin throughout the day with oil blotting sheets.

**9 Stop makeup from melting** Keep foundation, concealer and blush in place all day by prepping just-cleansed skin with a makeup primer instead of a moisturizer, says Devitt. The formulas smooth skin and create a nongreasy base for makeup.

**10 Unblock pores** To remove dead skin, dirt and sebum trapped in pores, Katz suggests using a face scrub three times a week. Skip heavy hair products, which cause hairline blemishes.

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
